Mrs. BONO (for herself and Mr. THOMPSON of California) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize leases for terms not to exceed 99 years on land held in trust for the Torres Martinez Desert Cahuilla Indians and the Guidiville Band of Pomo Indians of the Guidiville Indian Rancheria.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF 99-YEAR LEASES.**

4 The first section of the Act entitled “An Act to au-
5 thorize the leasing of restricted Indian lands for public,
6 religious, educational, residential, business, and other pur-
7 poses requiring the grant of long-term leases”, approved
8 August 9, 1955 (25 U.S.C. 415(a)), is amended by insert-

1 ing “lands held in trust for the Torres Martinez Desert
2 Cahuilla Indians, lands held in trust for the Guidiville
3 Band of Pomo Indians of the Guidiville Indian
4 Rancheria,” after “the Soboba Indian Reservation,”.

5 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6 The amendment made by section 1 shall apply to any
7 lease entered into or renewed after the date of the enact-
8 ment of this Act.
