3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The building of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 5 Cedar Street in Hopkinton, Massachusetts,
6 shall be known and designated as the “Thomas J. Brown
7 Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in any law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “Thomas J. Brown Post Office Building”.
