Mr. GOODLING introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

## A BILL

To expand the boundaries of the Gettysburg National Military Park to include the Wills House, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       (a) IN GENERAL.—The Act entitled “An Act to revise  
4 the boundary of the Gettysburg National Military Park  
5 in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and for other pur-  
6 poses” approved August 17, 1990 (16 U.S.C. 430g–4 et  
7 seq.) is amended—

8               (1) in section 1—

9                       (A) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-  
10                      section (c);

1 (B) by inserting after subsection (a) the  
2 following:

3 “(b) ADDITIONAL LANDS.—In addition to the lands  
4 identified in subsection (a), the park shall also include the  
5 property commonly known as the Wills House located in  
6 the Borough of Gettysburg and identified as Tract P02–  
7 1 on the map entitled ‘Gettysburg National Military Park’  
8 numbered MARO 305/80,011 Segment 2, and dated April  
9 1981, revised May 14, 1999.”; and

10 (C) in subsection (c), as so redesignated,  
11 by striking “in subsection (a)” and inserting  
12 “in subsections (a) and (b)”;  
13 (2) in section 2, by striking “1(b)” each place  
14 it appears and inserting “1(c)”.

15 (b) ACQUISITION AUTHORITY NOT EXPANDED.—  
16 Nothing in this Act is intended to or may be construed  
17 to grant the Secretary authority to acquire lands or inter-  
18 ests in lands.
