## A BILL

To amend the Act which established the Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site, in the State of New Hampshire, by modifying the boundary, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Saint-Gaudens Na-  
5 tional Historic Site Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 The Act of August 31, 1964 (78 Stat. 749), which  
8 established Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site, is  
9 amended—

1           (1) in section 3 by striking “not to exceed sixty-  
2           four acres of lands and interests therein” and insert-  
3           ing “215 acres of lands and buildings, or interests  
4           therein”;

5           (2) in section 6 by striking “\$2,677,000” from  
6           the first sentence and inserting “\$10,632,000”; and

7           (3) in section 6 by striking “\$80,000” from the  
8           last sentence and inserting “\$2,000,000”.
