2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 100 Orchard Park Drive in Greenville, South
6 Carolina, and known as the Orchard Park Station, shall
7 be known and designated as the “Keith D. Oglesby Sta-
8 tion”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “Keith D. Oglesby Station”.
