## AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to enter into contracts with the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District, Utah, to use Weber Basin Project facilities for the impounding, storage, and carriage of nonproject water for domestic, municipal, industrial, and other beneficial purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That the Secretary of the Interior may enter into con-  
4 tracts with the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District  
5 or any of its member unit contractors under the Act of  
6 February 21, 1911 (43 U.S.C. 523), for—

7            (1) the impounding, storage, and carriage of  
8        nonproject water for domestic, municipal, industrial,  
9        and other beneficial purposes, using facilities associ-  
10       ated with the Weber Basin Project, Utah; and

11           (2) the exchange of water among Weber Basin  
12       Project contractors, for the purposes set forth in  
13       paragraph (1), using facilities associated with the  
14       Weber Basin Project, Utah.
