A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2 The Federal building located at 158–15 Liberty Ave-
3 nue in Jamaica, Queens, New York, shall be known and
4 designated as the “Floyd H. Flake Federal Building”.

5 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

6 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
7 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
8 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
9 reference to the “Floyd H. Flake Federal Building”.
