AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make technical corrections to a map relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CORRECTIONS TO MAPS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior
5 shall, before the end of the 30-day period beginning on
6 the date of the enactment of this Act, make such correc-
7 tions to the map described in subsection (b) as are nec-

1 essary to ensure that depictions of areas on that map are
2 consistent with the depictions of areas appearing on the
3 map entitled “Amendments to the Coastal Barrier Re-
4 sources System”, dated _____, and on file with
5 the Committee on Resources of the House of Representa-
6 tives. *dated June 5, 2000.*

7 (b) MAP DESCRIBED.—The map described in this
8 subsection is the map that—

9 (1) is included in a set of maps entitled “Coast-
10 al Barrier Resources System”, dated November 2,
11 1994; and

12 (2) relates to unit P19–P of the Coastal Bar-
13 rier Resources System.

14 (c) AVAILABILITY.—*The Secretary of the Interior shall*
15 *keep the map described in subsection (b) on file and avail-*
16 *able for public inspection in accordance with section 4(b)*
17 *of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).*
