Mr. FRANKS of New Jersey introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to require air carriers to require passengers before boarding an aircraft to provide government-issued identification.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 44901 of title 49, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) in subsection (c)(1) by inserting “(other
6 than subsection (d))” after “this section”; and

7 (2) by adding at the end the following:

8 “(d) PREBOARDING IDENTIFICATION.—No air car-
9 rier may permit a passenger to board an aircraft in air

1 transportation or intrastate air transportation unless such
2 passenger at the time of boarding provides a government-
3 issued identification with a picture of such passenger or
4 2 government-issued identifications of such passenger
5 without a picture.”.
