## A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to provide for the forgiveness of Perkins loans to members of the armed services on active duty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CANCELLATION OF STUDENT LOANS FOR MILI-**  
4 **TARY SERVICE.**

5 Section 465(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965  
6 (20 U.S.C. 1087ee(a)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking subparagraph  
8 (E) and inserting the following:

1           “(D) as a member of the Armed Forces of the  
2           United States on active duty, as defined in section  
3           101(d)(1) of title 10, United States Code;”;  
4           (2) in paragraph (3)(A)—  
5           (A) by inserting “(D),” after “(A), (C),”  
6           in clause (i);  
7           (A) by inserting “or” after the semicolon  
8           at the end of clause (ii);  
9           (B) by striking clause (iii); and  
10           (C) by redesignating clause (iv) as clause  
11           (iii).
