## A BILL

To authorize a study concerning the George C. Marshall  
Plaza in Uniontown, Pennsylvania.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “George C. Marshall  
5       Memorial Plaza Study Act of 2000”.

6       **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF STUDY.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior  
8       (“the Secretary”) shall conduct a study to determine the  
9       national significance of the George C. Marshall Memorial  
10       Plaza in Uniontown, Pennsylvania, and the suitability and

1 feasibility of establishing the site as a unit of the National  
2 Park System.

3 (b) CRITERIA.—In conducting the study authorized  
4 by this Act, the Secretary shall use the criteria for the  
5 study of areas for potential inclusion in the National Park  
6 System contained in section 8 of Public Law 91–383  
7 (commonly known as the National Park System General  
8 Authorities Act; 16 U.S.C. 1a–5).

9 **SEC. 3. REPORT.**

10 Upon completion of the study, the Secretary shall  
11 submit to the Committee on Energy and Natural Re-  
12 sources of the Senate and the Committee on Resources  
13 of the House of Representatives a report on the findings,  
14 conclusions, and recommendations of the study.

15 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

16 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums  
17 as are necessary to carry out this Act.
