AN ACT

To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1602 Frankford Avenue in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, as the “Joseph F. Smith Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

2 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
3 cated at 1602 Frankford Avenue in Philadelphia, Pennsyl-
4 vania, and known as the Kensington Station, shall be
5 known and designated as the “Joseph F. Smith Post Of-
6 fice Building”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
10 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
11 to the “Joseph F. Smith Post Office Building”.
