 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

10 Service Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12501 et seq.).

25 an amount of not more than \$15,000,000 to provide

1 operational support to programs that receive ap-
2 proved national service positions under this subtitle
3 but do not receive funds under section 121(a).

4 “(2) LIMITATION ON AMOUNT OF OPERATIONAL
5 SUPPORT.—The amount of operational support pro-
6 vided under this subsection may not exceed \$1,000
7 per individual placed in an approved national service
8 position in such a program.

9 “(3) NO ADMINISTRATIVE COST, MATCHING
10 FUND, AND PARTICIPANT BENEFIT REQUIRE-
11 MENTS.—Programs supported under this subsection
12 shall not be subject to the administrative cost,

22 members of the Corps and shall be provided the
23 rights and benefits applicable to Corps mem-
24 bers, except that the limitation on the amount

1 of the living allowance available under section
2 158(b) shall not apply.”.
