A BILL

To make illegal the sale, share, or transfer of information acquired on the Internet with a pledge that it would not be released.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SALE OF PRIVATE INFORMATION.**

4 It shall be considered an unfair practice in or affect-
5 ing commerce which violates section 5 of the Federal
6 Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 45) for a person to sell
7 on the Internet information such person acquired with a
8 pledge that the information would be kept private and not
