A BILL

1 **CHAPTER 2—SPECIAL CLASSIFICATION**
 2 **RELATING TO PRODUCT DEVELOP-**
 3 **MENT AND TESTING**

4 **SEC. 1411. SHORT TITLE.**

5 *This chapter may be cited as the “Product Develop-*
 6 *ment and Testing Act of 2000”.*

7 **SEC. 1412. FINDINGS; PURPOSE.**

8 *(a) FINDINGS.—The Congress finds the following:*

9 *(1)(A) A substantial amount of development and*
 10 *testing occurs in the United States incident to the in-*
 11 *troduction and manufacture of new products for both*
 12 *domestic consumption and export overseas.*

13 *(B) Testing also occurs with respect to merchan-*
 14 *dise that has already been introduced into commerce*
 15 *to insure that it continues to meet specifications and*
 16 *performs as designed.*

17 *(2) The development and testing that occurs in*
 18 *the United States incident to the introduction and*
 19 *manufacture of new products, and with respect to*
 20 *products which have already been introduced into*
 21 *commerce, represents a significant industrial activity*
 22 *employing highly-skilled workers in the United States.*

23 *(3)(A) Under the current laws affecting the im-*
 24 *portation of merchandise, such as the provisions of*

1 *part I of title IV of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.*
2 *1401 et seq.), goods commonly referred to as “proto-*
3 *types”, used for product development testing and*
4 *product evaluation purposes, are subject to customs*
5 *duty upon their importation into the United States*
6 *unless the prototypes qualify for duty-free treatment*
7 *under special trade programs or unless the prototypes*
8 *are entered under a temporary importation bond.*

9 *(B) In addition, the United States Customs*
10 *Service has determined that the value of prototypes is*
11 *to be included in the value of production articles if*
12 *the prototypes are the result of the same design and*
13 *development effort as the articles.*

14 *(4)(A) Assessing duty on prototypes twice, once*
15 *when the prototypes are imported and a second time*
16 *thereafter as part of the cost of imported production*
17 *merchandise, discourages development and testing in*
18 *the United States, and thus encourages development*
19 *and testing to occur overseas, since, in that case, duty*
20 *will only be assessed once, upon the importation of*
21 *production merchandise.*

22 *(B) Assessing duty on these prototypes twice un-*
23 *necessarily inflates the cost to businesses, thus reduc-*
24 *ing their competitiveness.*

1 *development, testing, product evaluation, or quality*
2 *control purposes; and*

3 “(i) *in the case of originals or models of articles that are*
4 *either in the production or postproduction stage, are*
5 *associated with a design change from current produc-*
6 *tion (including a refinement, advancement, improve-*
7 *ment, development, or quality control in either the*
8 *product itself or the means for producing the product).*
9 *For purposes of clause (i), automobile racing shall not be*
10 *considered to be “development, testing, product evalua-*
11 *tion, or quality control.”.*

12 “(b)(i) *Prototypes (as defined in paragraph (a)) may only*
13 *be imported in limited noncommercial quantities in ac-*
14 *cordance with industry practice.*

15 “(i) *Prototypes (as defined in paragraph (a)), or parts of*
16 *prototypes, may not be sold (including sale for scrap*
17 *purposes) after importation into the United States or*
18 *be incorporated into other products.*

19 “(c) *Articles subject to quantitative restrictions, anti-*
20 *dumping orders, or countervailing duty orders, may*
21 *not be classified as prototypes under this note. Articles*
22 *subject to licensing requirements, or which must comply*
23 *with laws, rules, or regulations administered by agen-*
24 *cies other than the United States Customs Service be-*
25 *fore being imported, may be classified as prototypes,*

1 *provided that they comply with all applicable provi-*
2 *sions of law and otherwise meet the definition of ‘proto-*
3 *types’ under paragraph (a).”.*

4 **SEC. 1414. ENTRY PROCEDURES.**

5 *The Secretary of the Treasury shall establish regula-*
6 *tions for the identification of prototypes at the time of im-*
7 *portation into the United States in accordance with the*
8 *provisions of this chapter and the amendments made by this*
9 *chapter.*

10 **SEC. 1415. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

11 *This chapter, and the amendments made by this chap-*
12 *ter, shall apply with respect to—*

13 (1) *an entry of a prototype under heading*
14 *9817.85.01, as added by section 1413(a), on or after*
15 *the date of the enactment of this Act; and*

16 (2) *an entry of a prototype (as defined in U.S.*
17 *Note 6(a) to subchapter XVII of chapter 98, as added*
18 *by section 1413(b)) under heading 9813.00.30 for*
19 *which liquidation has not become final as of the date*
20 *of enactment of this Act.*

1 **CHAPTER 3—PROHIBITION ON IMPORTA-**
2 **TION OF PRODUCTS MADE WITH DOG**
3 **OR CAT FUR**

4 **SEC. 1421. SHORT TITLE.**

5 *This chapter may be cited as the “Dog and Cat Protec-*
6 *tion Act of 2000”.*

7 **SEC. 1422. FINDINGS AND PURPOSES.**

8 *(a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following findings:*

9 *(1) An estimated 2,000,000 dogs and cats are*
10 *slaughtered and sold annually as part of the inter-*
11 *national fur trade. Internationally, dog and cat fur*
12 *is used in a wide variety of products, including fur*
13 *coats and jackets, fur trimmed garments, hats, gloves,*
14 *decorative accessories, stuffed animals, and other toys.*

15 *(2) The United States represents one of the larg-*
16 *est markets for the sale of fur and fur products in the*
17 *world. Market demand for fur products in the United*
18 *States has led to the introduction of dog and cat fur*
19 *products into United States commerce, frequently*
20 *based on deceptive or fraudulent labeling of the prod-*
21 *ucts to disguise the true origin of the fur.*

22 *(3) Dog and cat fur, when dyed, is not easily*
23 *distinguishable to persons who are not experts from*
24 *other furs such as fox, rabbit, coyote, wolf, and mink,*
25 *and synthetic materials made to resemble real fur.*

1 *Dog and cat fur is generally less expensive than other*
2 *types of fur and may be used as a substitute for more*
3 *expensive types of furs, which provides an incentive*
4 *to engage in unfair or fraudulent trade practices in*
5 *the importation, exportation, distribution, or sale of*
6 *fur products, including deceptive labeling and other*
7 *practices designed to disguise the true contents or ori-*
8 *gin of the product.*

9 *(4) Forensic texts have documented that dog and*
10 *cat fur products are being imported into the United*
11 *States subject to deceptive labels or other practices de-*
12 *signed to conceal the use of dog or cat fur in the pro-*
13 *duction of wearing apparel, toys, and other products.*

14 *(5) Publicly available evidence reflects ongoing*
15 *significant use of dogs and cats bred expressly for*
16 *their fur by foreign fur producers for manufacture*
17 *into wearing apparel, toys, and other products that*
18 *have been introduced into United States commerce.*
19 *The evidence indicates that foreign fur producers also*
20 *rely on the use of stray dogs and cats and stolen pets*
21 *for the manufacture of fur products destined for the*
22 *world and United States markets.*

23 *(6) The methods of housing, transporting, and*
24 *slaughtering dogs and cats for fur production are gen-*
25 *erally unregulated and inhumane.*

1 (7) *The trade of dog and cat fur products is ethi-*
2 *cally and aesthetically abhorrent to United States*
3 *citizens. Consumers in the United States have a right*
4 *to know if products offered for sale contain dog or cat*
5 *fur and to ensure that they are not unwitting partici-*
6 *pants in this gruesome trade.*

7 (8) *Persons who engage in the sale of dog or cat*
8 *fur products, including the fraudulent trade practices*
9 *identified above, gain an unfair competitive advan-*
10 *tage over persons who engage in legitimate trade in*
11 *apparel, toys, and other products, and derive an un-*
12 *fair benefit from consumers who buy their products.*

13 (9) *The imposition of a ban on the sale, manu-*
14 *facture, offer for sale, transportation, and distribution*
15 *of dog and cat fur products, regardless of their source,*
16 *is consistent with the international obligations of the*
17 *United States as it applies equally to domestic and*
18 *foreign entities. Such a ban is also consistent with*
19 *provisions of international agreements to which the*
20 *United States is a party that expressly allow for*
21 *measures designed to protect the health and welfare of*
22 *animals and to enjoin the use of deceptive trade prac-*
23 *tices in international or domestic commerce.*

24 (b) *PURPOSES.*—*The purposes of this chapter are to—*

1 (1) *prohibit imports, exports, sale, manufacture,*
2 *offer for sale, transportation, and distribution in the*
3 *United States of dog and cat fur products, in order*
4 *to ensure that United States market demand does not*
5 *provide an incentive to slaughter dogs or cats for*
6 *their fur;*

7 (2) *require accurate labeling of fur species so*
8 *that consumers in the United States can make in-*
9 *formed choices and ensure that they are not unwitting*
10 *contributors to this gruesome trade; and*

11 (3) *ensure that the customs laws of the United*
12 *States are not undermined by illicit international*
13 *traffic in dog and cat fur products.*

14 **SEC. 1423. PROHIBITION ON IMPORTATION OF PRODUCTS**
15 **MADE WITH DOG OR CAT FUR.**

16 *Title III of the Tariff Act of 1930 is amended by in-*
17 *serting after section 307 the following new section:*

18 **“SEC. 308. PROHIBITIONS ON IMPORTATION OF AND OTHER**
19 **COMMERCE IN DOG AND CAT FUR PRODUCTS.**

20 “(a) *DEFINITIONS.—In this section:*

21 “(1) *CAT FUR.—The term ‘cat fur’ means the*
22 *pelt or skin of any animal of the species Felis catus.*

23 “(2) *COMMERCE.—The term ‘commerce’ means*
24 *the transportation for sale, trade, or use between any*
25 *State, territory, or possession of the United States, or*

1 *the District of Columbia, and any place outside there-*
2 *of.*

3 “(3) *CUSTOMS LAWS.*—*The term ‘customs laws of*
4 *the United States’ means any other law or regulation*
5 *enforced or administered by the United States Cus-*
6 *toms Service.*

7 “(4) *DOG FUR.*—*The term ‘dog fur’ means the*
8 *pelt or skin of any animal of the species *Canis**
9 *familiaris.*

10 “(5) *DOG OR CAT FUR PRODUCT.*—*The term ‘dog*
11 *or cat fur product’ means any item of merchandise*
12 *which consists, or is composed in whole or in part,*
13 *of any dog fur, cat fur, or both.*

14 “(6) *PERSON.*—*The term ‘person’ includes any*
15 *individual, partnership, corporation, association, or-*
16 *ganization, business trust, government entity, or other*
17 *entity subject to the jurisdiction of the United States.*

18 “(7) *SECRETARY.*—*The term ‘Secretary’ means*
19 *the Secretary of the Treasury.*

20 “(8) *UNITED STATES.*—*The term ‘United States’*
21 *means the customs territory of the United States, as*
22 *defined in general note 2 of the Harmonized Tariff*
23 *Schedule of the United States.*

24 “(b) *PROHIBITIONS.*—*It shall be unlawful for any per-*
25 *son to—*

1 “(1) *import into, or export from, the United*
2 *States any dog or cat fur product; or*

3 “(2) *introduce into interstate commerce, manu-*
4 *facture for introduction into interstate commerce, sell,*
5 *trade, or advertise in interstate commerce, offer to*
6 *sell, or transport or distribute in interstate commerce*
7 *in the United States, any dog or cat fur product.*

8 *This subsection shall not apply to the importation, expor-*
9 *tation, or transportation by an individual, for noncommer-*
10 *cial purposes, of his or her personal pet that is deceased,*
11 *including a pet preserved through taxidermy.*

12 “(c) *PENALTIES AND ENFORCEMENT.—*

13 “(1) *CIVIL PENALTIES.—Any person who violates*
14 *any provision of this section or any regulation issued*
15 *under this section may, in addition to any other civil*
16 *or criminal penalty that may be imposed under sec-*
17 *tion 592 of this Act or any other provision of law, be*
18 *assessed a civil penalty by the Secretary of not more*
19 *than \$5,000.*

20 “(2) *ENFORCEMENT.—The provisions of this sec-*
21 *tion and any regulations issued under this section*
22 *shall be enforced by the Secretary. In imposing pen-*
23 *alties under paragraph (1), the Secretary shall take*
24 *into account the seriousness of the violation, the cul-*
25 *pability of the violator, and the violator’s record of*

1 *cooperating with the Government in disclosing the*
2 *violation.*

3 “(3) *REGULATIONS.*—*Not later than 180 days*
4 *after the date of enactment of this section, the Sec-*
5 *retary shall, after notice and opportunity for com-*
6 *ment, issue regulations to carry out the provisions of*
7 *this section.*

8 “(4) *COORDINATION WITH OTHER LAWS.*—*Noth-*
9 *ing in this section shall be construed as superseding*
10 *or limiting in any manner the functions and respon-*
11 *sibilities of the Secretary of the Treasury under the*
12 *customs laws of the United States.*

13 “(d) *REPORTS.*—*In order to enable Congress to engage*
14 *in active, continuing oversight of this section, the Secretary*
15 *shall provide the following:*

16 “(1) *PLAN FOR ENFORCEMENT.*—*Within 3*
17 *months after the date of enactment of this section, the*
18 *Secretary shall submit to Congress a plan for the en-*
19 *forcement of the provisions of this section, including*
20 *training and procedures to ensure that Customs Serv-*
21 *ice personnel are equipped with state-of-the-art tech-*
22 *nologies to identify potential dog or cat fur products*
23 *and to determine the true content of such products.*

24 “(2) *REPORT ON ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS.*—*Not*
25 *later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this*

1 *section, and on an annual basis thereafter, the Sec-*
 2 *retary shall submit a report to Congress on the efforts*
 3 *of the Department of the Treasury to enforce the pro-*
 4 *visions of this section and the adequacy of the re-*
 5 *sources to do so. The report shall include an analysis*
 6 *of the training of Customs Service personnel to iden-*
 7 *tify dog and cat fur products effectively and to take*
 8 *appropriate action to enforce this section.”.*

9 **CHAPTER 4—MISCELLANEOUS**
 10 **PROVISIONS**

11 **SEC. 1431. ALTERNATIVE MID-POINT INTEREST ACCOUNT-**
 12 **ING METHODOLOGY FOR UNDERPAYMENT OF**
 13 **DUTIES AND FEES.**

14 *Section 505(c) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.*
 15 *1505(c)) is amended by striking “For the period beginning*
 16 *on” and all that follows through “the Secretary may pre-*
 17 *scribe” and inserting “The Secretary may prescribe”.*

18 **SEC. 1432. EXCEPTION FROM MAKING REPORT OF ARRIVAL**
 19 **AND FORMAL ENTRY FOR CERTAIN VESSELS.**

20 *(a) REPORT OF ARRIVAL AND FORMAL ENTRY OF VES-*
 21 *SELS.—(1) Section 433(a)(1)(C) of the Tariff Act of 1930*
 22 *(19 U.S.C. 1433(a)(1)(C)) is amended by striking “bonded*
 23 *merchandise, or”.*

1 (2) Section 434(a)(3) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19
2 U.S.C. 1434(a)(3)) is amended by striking “bonded mer-
3 chandise or”.

4 (3) Section 91(a)(2) of the Appendix to title 46, United
5 States Code, is amended by striking “bonded merchandise
6 or”.

7 (b) *ADDITIONAL AMENDMENT.*—Section 441 of the
8 Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1441) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following new paragraph:

10 “(7) Any vessel required to anchor at the Belle
11 Isle Anchorage in the waters of the Detroit River in
12 the State of Michigan, for the purposes of awaiting
13 the availability of cargo or berthing space or for the
14 purpose of taking on a pilot or awaiting pilot serv-
15 ices, or at the direction of the Coast Guard, prior to
16 proceeding to the Port of Toledo, Ohio, where the ves-
17 sel makes entry under section 434 or obtains clear-
18 ance under section 4197 of the Revised Statutes of the
19 United States.”.

20 **SEC. 1433. DESIGNATION OF SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL**
21 **AIRPORT FOR CUSTOMS PROCESSING OF**
22 **CERTAIN PRIVATE AIRCRAFT ARRIVING IN**
23 **THE UNITED STATES.**

24 (a) *DESIGNATION.*—For the 2-year period beginning
25 on the date of the enactment of this Act, the Commissioner

1 of the Customs Service shall designate the San Antonio
2 International Airport in San Antonio, Texas, as an airport
3 at which private aircraft described in subsection (b) may
4 land for processing by the Customs Service in accordance
5 with section 122.24(b) of title 19, Code of Federal Regula-
6 tions.

7 (b) *PRIVATE AIRCRAFT*.—Private aircraft described in
8 this subsection are private aircraft that—

9 (1) arrive in the United States from a foreign
10 area and have a final destination in the United
11 States of San Antonio International Airport in San
12 Antonio, Texas; and

13 (2) would otherwise be required to land for proc-
14 essing by the Customs Service at an airport listed in
15 section 122.24(b) of title 19, Code of Federal Regula-
16 tions, in accordance with such section.

17 (c) *DEFINITION*.—In this section, the term “private
18 aircraft” has the meaning given such term in section
19 122.23(a)(1) of title 19, Code of Federal Regulations.

20 (d) *REPORT*.—The Commissioner of the Customs Serv-
21 ice shall prepare and submit to Congress a report on the
22 implementation of this section for 2001 and 2002.

23 **SEC. 1434. INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL MERCHANDISE.**

24 Section 555 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1555)
25 is amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(c) *INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL MERCHANDISE.*—

2 “(1) *DEFINITIONS.*—*For purposes of this*
3 *section—*

4 “(A) *the term ‘international travel mer-*
5 *chandise’ means duty-free or domestic merchan-*
6 *dise which is placed on board aircraft on inter-*
7 *national flights for sale to passengers, but which*
8 *is not merchandise incidental to the operation of*
9 *a duty-free sales enterprise;*

10 “(B) *the term ‘staging area’ is an area con-*
11 *trolled by the proprietor of a bonded warehouse*
12 *outside of the physical parameters of the bonded*
13 *warehouse in which manipulation of inter-*
14 *national travel merchandise in carts occurs;*

15 “(C) *the term ‘duty-free merchandise’ means*
16 *merchandise on which the liability for payment*
17 *of duty or tax imposed by reason of importation*
18 *has been deferred pending exportation from the*
19 *customs territory;*

20 “(D) *the term ‘manipulation’ means the re-*
21 *packaging, cleaning, sorting, or removal from or*
22 *placement on carts of international travel mer-*
23 *chandise; and*

1 “(E) the term ‘cart’ means a portable con-
2 tainer holding international travel merchandise
3 on an aircraft for exportation.

4 “(2) *BONDED WAREHOUSE FOR INTERNATIONAL*
5 *TRAVEL MERCHANDISE.*—*The Secretary shall by regu-*
6 *lation establish a separate class of bonded warehouse*
7 *for the storage and manipulation of international*
8 *travel merchandise pending its placement on board*
9 *aircraft departing for foreign destinations.*

10 “(3) *RULES FOR TREATMENT OF INTERNATIONAL*
11 *TRAVEL MERCHANDISE AND BONDED WAREHOUSES*
12 *AND STAGING AREAS.*—(A) *The proprietor of a bonded*
13 *warehouse established for the storage and manipula-*
14 *tion of international travel merchandise shall give a*
15 *bond in such sum and with such sureties as may be*
16 *approved by the Secretary of the Treasury to secure*
17 *the Government against any loss or expense connected*
18 *with or arising from the deposit, storage, or manipu-*
19 *lation of merchandise in such warehouse. The ware-*
20 *house proprietor’s bond shall also secure the manipu-*
21 *lation of international travel merchandise in a stag-*
22 *ing area.*

23 “(B) *A transfer of liability from the inter-*
24 *national carrier to the warehouse proprietor occurs*
25 *when the carrier assigns custody of international*

1 *travel merchandise to the warehouse proprietor for*
2 *purposes of entry into warehouse or for manipulation*
3 *in the staging area.*

4 *“(C) A transfer of liability from the warehouse*
5 *proprietor to the international carrier occurs when*
6 *the bonded warehouse proprietor assigns custody of*
7 *international travel merchandise to the carrier.*

8 *“(D) The Secretary is authorized to promulgate*
9 *regulations to require the proprietor and the inter-*
10 *national carrier to keep records of the disposition of*
11 *any cart brought into the United States and all mer-*
12 *chandise on such cart.”.*

13 **SEC. 1435. CHANGE IN RATE OF DUTY OF GOODS RETURNED**
14 **TO THE UNITED STATES BY TRAVELERS.**

15 *Subchapter XVI of chapter 98 is amended as follows:*

16 *(1) Subheading 9816.00.20 is amended—*

17 *(A) effective January 1, 2000, by striking*
18 *“10 percent” each place it appears and inserting*
19 *“5 percent”;*

20 *(B) effective January 1, 2001, by striking*
21 *“5 percent” each place it appears and inserting*
22 *“4 percent”; and*

23 *(C) effective January 1, 2002, by striking*
24 *“4 percent” each place it appears and inserting*
25 *“3 percent”.*

1 (2) *Subheading 9816.00.40 is amended—*
