2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Teacher Loan Forgive-
5 ness Act of 2000”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN AMOUNT OF STUDENT LOANS ELIGI-**
7 **BLE FOR FORGIVENESS FOR SERVICE AS A**
8 **TEACHER.**

9 (a) **GUARANTEED LOANS.**—Section 428J(c)(1) of the
10 Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1078–10(c)(1))

1 is amended by striking “\$5,000” and inserting
2 “\$12,800”.

3 (b) DIRECT LOANS.—Section 460(c)(1) of the Higher
4 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087j(e)(1)) is amend-
5 ed by striking “\$5,000” and inserting “\$12,800”.
