A BILL

To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 514 Express Center Drive in Chicago, Illinois, as the “J.T. Weeker Service Center”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. J.T. WEEKER SERVICE CENTER.**

4 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
5 States Postal Service located at 514 Express Center Drive
6 in Chicago, Illinois, and known as the Chicago Inter-

1 national/Military Service Center, shall be known and des-
2 ignated as the “J.T. Weeker Service Center”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “J.T. Weeker Service
7 Center”.
