## A BILL

To direct the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration to treat certain property boundaries as the boundaries of the Lawrence County Airport, Courtland, Alabama, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. LAWRENCE COUNTY AIRPORT, COURTLAND,**  
4                               **ALABAMA.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—With respect to the airport lo-  
6       cated at Courtland, Lawrence County, Alabama (formerly  
7       known as the George C. Wallace Airport), the Adminis-  
8       trator of the Federal Aviation Administration shall treat

1 as the boundaries of the airport property those boundaries  
2 shown on the airport layout drawing produced by Garver,  
3 Inc., dated March 8, 1999, and approved by the Jackson  
4 Airport District Office of the Administration.

5 (b) TREATMENT OF NONAIRPORT PROPERTY.—The  
6 Administrator may not treat as airport property any real  
7 property not designated as airport property in the drawing  
8 referred to in subsection (a) regardless of whether such  
9 real property was designated as airport property at any  
10 time prior to March 8, 1999.
