Mr. SAXTON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Richard Steinmetz.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELIEF OF RICHARD STEINMETZ.**

4 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
5 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to
6 Richard Steinmetz of Vincentown, New Jersey,
7 \$25,000.00 for services rendered and costs incurred in ob-
8 taining the ship's bell from the C.S.S. ALABAMA and re-
9 turning that bell to the United States.

10 **SEC. 2. FULL SATISFACTION.**

11 The relief under section 1 shall, when accepted by
12 or on behalf of Richard Steinmetz, be in full satisfaction

1 of all claims of or on behalf of Richard Steinmetz against
2 the United States or against any officer, employee, or
3 agent of the United States acting within the scope of em-
4 ployment or agency, for payment for the services and costs
5 described in section 1.

6 **SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY FEES.**

7 It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-
8 cent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be paid
9 to, or received by, any agent or attorney for any service
10 rendered in connection with the claim described in such
11 section. Any person who violates this section shall be
12 guilty of an infraction, and shall be subject to a fine in
13 the amount provided in title 18, United States Code.
