## A BILL

To designate a portion of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area in Minnesota as the “Bruce F. Vento Unit of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. BRUCE F. VENTO UNIT OF THE BOUNDARY WA-**  
4 **TERS CANOE AREA WILDERNESS, MIN-**  
5 **NESOTA.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—The portion of the Boundary  
7 Waters Canoe Area Wilderness, Minnesota, situated north  
8 and east of the Gunflint Corridor and that is bounded by  
9 the United States border with Canada to the north shall

1 be known and designated as the “Bruce F. Vento Unit  
2 of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness”.

3 (b) **LEGAL REFERENCE.**—Any reference in a law,  
4 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the  
5 United States to the area referred to in paragraph (1)  
6 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Bruce F. Vento  
7 Unit of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness”.
