2 the “Mervyn Malcolm Dymally Post Office Building”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
6 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
7 a reference to the “Mervyn Malcolm Dymally Post Office
8 Building”.
