1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.**

4 Section 149 of title I of division C of Public Law 105-
5 277 is amended—

6 (1) by striking “April 1, 1999” each place it
7 appears and inserting “July 1, 1999”,

8 (2) in subsection (a)—

1 (A) by striking “September 30, 1998” and
2 inserting “March 31, 1999”, and

3 (B) by striking “October 1, 1998” and in-
4 sserting “April 1, 1999”, and

5 (3) by striking subsection (c).

6 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

7 The amendments made by section 1 shall take effect
8 on April 1, 1999.
