## A BILL

Designating certain land in the San Isabel National Forest in the State of Colorado as the “Spanish Peaks Wilderness”.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Spanish Peaks Wilder-  
5        ness Act of 1999”.

1 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF SPANISH PEAKS WILDERNESS.**

2 (a) COLORADO WILDERNESS ACT.—Section 2(a) of  
3 the Colorado Wilderness Act of 1993 (Public Law 103–  
4 77; 107 Stat. 756; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note) is amended by  
5 adding at the end the following:

6 “(20) SPANISH PEAKS WILDERNESS.—Certain  
7 land in the San Isabel National Forest that—

8 “(A) comprises approximately 18,000  
9 acres, as generally depicted on a map entitled  
10 ‘Proposed Spanish Peaks Wilderness’, dated  
11 February 10, 1999; and

12 “(B) shall be known as the ‘Spanish Peaks  
13 Wilderness’.”.

14 (b) MAP; BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION.—

15 (1) FILING.—As soon as practicable after the  
16 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agri-  
17 culture (referred to in this Act as the “Secretary”),  
18 shall file a map and boundary description of the  
19 area designated under subsection (a) with—

20 (A) the Committee on Resources of the  
21 House of Representatives; and

22 (B) the Committee on Energy and Natural  
23 Resources of the Senate.

24 (2) FORCE AND EFFECT.—The map and bound-  
25 ary description under paragraph (1) shall have the  
26 same force and effect as if included in the Colorado

1 Wilderness Act of 1993 (Public Law 103–77; 107  
2 Stat. 756), except that the Secretary may correct  
3 clerical and typographical errors in the map and  
4 boundary description.

5 (3) AVAILABILITY.—The map and boundary de-  
6 scription under paragraph (1) shall be on file and  
7 available for public inspection in the Office of the  
8 Chief of the Forest Service.

9 **SEC. 3. ACCESS.**

10 Within the Spanish Peaks Wilderness designated  
11 under section 2—

12 (1) the Secretary shall allow the continuation of  
13 historic uses of the Bulls Eye Mine Road established  
14 prior to the date of enactment of this Act, subject  
15 to such terms and conditions as the Secretary may  
16 provide; and

17 (2) access to any privately owned land within  
18 the wilderness areas designated under section 2 shall  
19 be provided in accordance with section 5 of the Wil-  
20 derness Act (16 U.S.C. 1134 et seq.).

21 **SEC. 4. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**

22 Section 10 of the Colorado Wilderness Act of 1993  
23 (Public Law 103–77; 107 Stat. 756; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note)  
24 is repealed.
