Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 1553) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2000 and fiscal year 2001 for the National Weather Service, Atmospheric Research, and National Environmental Satellite, Data and Information Service activities of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 1553) to authorize appropriations  
3 for fiscal year 2000 and fiscal year 2001 for the National  
4 Weather Service, Atmospheric Research, and National En-  
5 vironmental Satellite, Data and Information Service ac-  
6 tivities of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Adminis-  
7 tration, and for other purposes. The first reading of the  
8 bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order against consid-  
9 eration of the bill for failure to comply with clause 4(a)  
10 of rule XIII are waived. General debate shall be confined  
11 to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided  
12 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority  
13 member of the Committee on Science. After general debate  
14 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
15 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original  
16 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute  
17 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-  
18 ommended by the Committee on Science now printed in  
19 the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
20 stitute shall be considered as read. During consideration  
21 of the bill for amendment, the chairman of the Committee  
22 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the  
23 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has  
24 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional  
25 Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule

1 XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as  
2 read. The chairman of the Committee of the Whole may:  
3 (1) postpone until a time during further consideration in  
4 the Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote  
5 on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the  
6 minimum time for electronic voting on any postponed  
7 question that follows another electronic vote without inter-  
8 vening business, provided that the minimum time for elec-  
9 tronic voting on the first in any series of questions shall  
10 be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consideration of the  
11 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report  
12 the bill to the House with such amendments as may have  
13 been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote  
14 in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-  
15 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amend-  
16 ment in the nature of a substitute. The previous question  
17 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments  
18 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except  
19 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
