RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1259) to amend the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to protect Social Security surpluses through strengthened budgetary enforcement mechanisms.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 1259) to amend the Congressional Budget Act of 1974
4 to protect Social Security surpluses through strengthened
5 budgetary enforcement mechanisms. The bill shall be con-
6 sidered as read for amendment. The amendment specified

1 in section 2 of this resolution shall be considered as adopt-
2 ed. The previous question shall be considered as ordered
3 on the bill, as amended, to final passage without inter-
4 vening motion except: (1) two hours of debate equally di-
5 vided and controlled among the chairmen and ranking mi-
6 nority members of the Committees on the Budget, Rules,
7 and Ways and Means; and (2) one motion to recommit
8 with or without instructions.

9 SEC. 2. The amendment considered as adopted is as
10 follows: page 3, line 13, strike “cause or increase” and
11 insert “set forth”.
