Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1000) to amend title 49, United States Code, to reauthorize programs of the Federal Aviation Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1000) to amend title 49, United
6 States Code, to reauthorize programs of the Federal Avia-

1 tion Administration, and for other purposes. The first
2 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
3 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
4 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
5 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
6 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Trans-
7 portation and Infrastructure. After general debate the bill
8 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
9 rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill
10 for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule
11 the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended
12 by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure
13 now printed in the bill, modified by the amendment print-
14 ed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules ac-
15 companying this resolution. That amendment in the na-
16 ture of a substitute shall be considered as read. All points
17 of order against that amendment in the nature of a sub-
18 stitute are waived. No further amendment to that amend-
19 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except
20 those printed in part B of the report of the Committee
21 on Rules. Each amendment may be offered only in the
22 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-
23 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,
24 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report
25 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an

1 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
2 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
3 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points
4 of order against the amendments printed in the report are
5 waived. The chairman of the Committee of the Whole may:
6 (1) postpone until a time during further consideration in
7 the Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote
8 on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the
9 minimum time for electronic voting on any postponed
10 question that follows another electronic vote without inter-
11 vening business, provided that the minimum time for elec-
12 tronic voting on the first in any series of questions shall
13 be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consideration of the
14 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report
15 the bill to the House with such amendments as may have
16 been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote
17 in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-
18 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in
19 the nature of a substitute made in order as original text.
20 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
21 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
22 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
23 or without instructions.
