Mrs. MYRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

# RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 2561) making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2561) making appropriations for  
6 the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending Sep-

1 tember 30, 2000, and for other purposes. All points of  
2 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General  
3 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
4 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
5 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-  
6 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
7 for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order  
8 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with  
9 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. During consideration of  
10 the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee  
11 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the  
12 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has  
13 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional  
14 Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule  
15 XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as  
16 read. The chairman of the Committee of the Whole may:  
17 (1) postpone until a time during further consideration in  
18 the Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote  
19 on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the  
20 minimum time for electronic voting on any postponed  
21 question that follows another electronic vote without inter-  
22 vening business, provided that the minimum time for elec-  
23 tronic voting on the first in any series of questions shall  
24 be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consideration of the  
25 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report

1 the bill to the House with such amendments as may have  
2 been adopted. The previous question shall be considered  
3 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
4 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
5 recommit with or without instructions.
