Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2605) making appropriations for energy and water development for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2605) making appropriations for  
6 energy and water development for the fiscal year ending

1 September 30, 2000, and for other purposes. The first  
2 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order  
3 against consideration of the bill for failure to comply with  
4 clause 4 of rule XIII are waived. General debate shall be  
5 confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally  
6 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
7 nority member of the Committee on Appropriations. After  
8 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment  
9 under the five-minute rule. Points of order against provi-  
10 sions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 or  
11 clause 5(a) of rule XXI are waived except as follows: page  
12 7, line 1, through page 9, line 2; page 36, lines 21 through  
13 25. During consideration of the bill for amendment, the  
14 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord pri-  
15 ority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member  
16 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the  
17 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that  
18 purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed  
19 shall be considered as read. The Chairman of the Com-  
20 mittee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during  
21 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-  
22 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) re-  
23 duce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic vot-  
24 ing on any postponed question that follows another elec-  
25 tronic vote without intervening business, provided that the

1 minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any se-  
2 ries of questions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion  
3 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee  
4 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such  
5 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous  
6 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
7 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
8 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
9 structions.
