Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1402) to require the Secretary of Agriculture to implement the Class I milk price structure known as Option 1A as part of the implementation of the final rule to consolidate Federal milk marketing orders.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1402) to require the Secretary of

1 Agriculture to implement the Class I milk price structure  
2 known as Option 1A as part of the implementation of the  
3 final rule to consolidate Federal milk marketing orders.  
4 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points  
5 of order against consideration of the bill for failure to com-  
6 ply with clause 3 of rule XIII or section 308(a) of the  
7 Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are waived. General de-  
8 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one  
9 hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and  
10 ranking minority member of the Committee on Agri-  
11 culture. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
12 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in  
13 order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of  
14 amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in  
15 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee  
16 on Agriculture now printed in the bill, modified by the  
17 amendments printed in part A of the report of the Com-  
18 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. That  
19 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-  
20 ered as read. Points of order against that amendment in  
21 the nature of a substitute for failure to comply with clause  
22 7 of rule XVI are waived. No amendment to that amend-  
23 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except  
24 those printed in part B of the report of the Committee  
25 on Rules. Each amendment may be offered only in the

1 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-  
2 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,  
3 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report  
4 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an  
5 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment except as  
6 specified in the report, and shall not be subject to a de-  
7 mand for division of the question in the House or in the  
8 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against the  
9 amendments printed in the report are waived. The Chair-  
10 man of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone  
11 until a time during further consideration in the Committee  
12 of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amend-  
13 ment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time  
14 for electronic voting on any postponed question that fol-  
15 lows another electronic vote without intervening business,  
16 provided that the minimum time for electronic voting on  
17 the first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes.  
18 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-  
19 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the  
20 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.  
21 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House  
22 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole  
23 to the bill or to the amendment in the nature of a sub-  
24 stitute made in order as original text. The previous ques-  
25 tion shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amend-

1 ments thereto to final passage without intervening motion  
2 except one motion to recommit with or without instruc-  
3 tions.
