Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1487) to provide for public participation in the declaration of national monuments under the Act popularly known as the Antiquities Act of 1906.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1487) to provide for public partici-

1 pation in the declaration of national monuments under the  
2 Act popularly known as the Antiquities Act of 1906. The  
3 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. General  
4 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
5 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
6 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Re-  
7 sources. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill  
8 for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule  
9 the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended  
10 by the Committee on Resources now printed in the bill.  
11 The committee amendment in the nature of a substitute  
12 shall be considered as read. During consideration of the  
13 bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of  
14 the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis  
15 of whether the Member offering an amendment has caused  
16 it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record  
17 designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII.  
18 Amendments so printed shall be considered as read. The  
19 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) post-  
20 pone until a time during further consideration in the Com-  
21 mittee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any  
22 amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum  
23 time for electronic voting on any postponed question that  
24 follows another electronic vote without intervening busi-  
25 ness, provided that the minimum time for electronic voting

1 on the first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes.  
2 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-  
3 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the  
4 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.  
5 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House  
6 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole  
7 to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature  
8 of a substitute. The previous question shall be considered  
9 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
10 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
11 recommit with or without instructions.
