Mr. GOSS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2506) to amend title IX of the Public Health Service Act to revise and extend the Agency for Health Care Policy and Research.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2506) to amend title IX of the Pub-
6 lic Health Service Act to revise and extend the Agency
7 for Health Care Policy and Research. The first reading

1 of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall
2 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
3 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
4 nority member of the Committee on Commerce. After gen-
5 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
6 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
7 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
8 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
9 stitute recommended by the Committee on Commerce now
10 printed in the bill. Each section of the committee amend-
11 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as
12 read. No amendment to the committee amendment in the
13 nature of a substitute shall be in order except those print-
14 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated
15 for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII and except pro-
16 forma amendments for the purpose of debate. Each
17 amendment so printed may be offered only by the Member
18 who caused it to be printed or his designee and shall be
19 considered as read. The Chairman of the Committee of
20 the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further
21 consideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for
22 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five
23 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any
24 postponed question that follows another electronic vote
25 without intervening business, provided that the minimum

1 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-
2 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-
3 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
4 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
5 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
6 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
7 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the com-
8 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The pre-
9 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
10 and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-
11 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or
12 without instructions.
