Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2679) to amend title 49, United States Code, to establish the National Motor Carrier Administration in the Department of Transportation, to improve the safety of commercial motor vehicle operators and carriers, to strengthen commercial driver's licenses, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 2679) to amend title 49, United  
3 States Code, to establish the National Motor Carrier Ad-  
4 ministration in the Department of Transportation, to im-  
5 prove the safety of commercial motor vehicle operators and  
6 carriers, to strengthen commercial driver's licenses, and  
7 for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be  
8 dispensed with. All points of order against the bill and  
9 against its consideration are waived. General debate shall  
10 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-  
11 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
12 nority member of the Committee on Transportation and  
13 Infrastructure. After general debate the bill shall be con-  
14 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The  
15 amendment printed in part A of the report of the Com-  
16 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be con-  
17 sidered as adopted in the House and in the Committee  
18 of the Whole. The bill, as amended, shall be considered  
19 by title rather than by section. Each title shall be consid-  
20 ered as read. Before consideration of any other amend-  
21 ment it shall be in order to consider the amendment print-  
22 ed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules,  
23 if offered by a Member designated in the report. That  
24 amendment shall be considered as read, may amend por-  
25 tions of the bill not yet read for amendment, and shall

1 not be subject to a demand for division of the question  
2 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. Points  
3 of order against that amendment for failure to comply  
4 with clause 7 of rule XVI are waived. During consider-  
5 ation of the bill for further amendment, the Chairman of  
6 the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-  
7 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an  
8 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of  
9 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in  
10 clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be  
11 considered as read. The Chairman of the Committee of  
12 the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further  
13 consideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for  
14 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five  
15 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any  
16 postponed question that follows another electronic vote  
17 without intervening business, provided that the minimum  
18 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-  
19 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-  
20 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
21 and report the bill, as amended, to the House with such  
22 further amendments as may have been adopted. The pre-  
23 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,  
24 as amended, and any further amendment thereto to final

- 1 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
- 2 recommit with or without instructions.
