Ms. PRYCE of Ohio, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2) to send more dollars to the classroom and for certain other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2) to send more dollars to the class-
6 room and for certain other purposes. The first reading of
7 the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against

1 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall
2 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed 90 minutes
3 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
4 ing minority member of the Committee on Education and
5 the Workforce. After general debate the bill shall be con-
6 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule for a
7 period not to exceed six hours. It shall be in order to con-
8 sider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment
9 under the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature
10 of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Edu-
11 cation and the Workforce now printed in the bill. The com-
12 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be
13 considered as read. All points of order against the com-
14 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute are
15 waived. No amendment to the committee amendment in
16 the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
17 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-
18 igned for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII and
19 except pro forma amendments for the purpose of debate.
20 Each amendment so printed may be offered only by the
21 Member who caused it to be printed or his designee and
22 shall be considered as read. The amendment numbered 5
23 shall not be subject to amendment and shall not be subject
24 to a demand for division of the question in the House or
25 in the Committee of the Whole. The Chairman of the Com-

1 mittee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during
2 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-
3 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) re-
4 duce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic vot-
5 ing on any postponed question that follows another elec-
6 tronic vote without intervening business, provided that the
7 minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any se-
8 ries of questions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion
9 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
10 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
11 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
12 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
13 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
14 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
15 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
16 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
17 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
18 or without instructions.
