Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3843) to reauthorize programs to assist small business concerns, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3843) to reauthorize programs to
6 assist small business concerns, and for other purposes.
7 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All

1 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
2 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
3 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
4 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
5 on Small Business. After general debate the bill shall be
6 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule.
7 Each section of the bill shall be considered as read. During
8 consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of
9 the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
10 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
11 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
12 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
13 clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be
14 considered as read. The Chairman of the Committee of
15 the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further
16 consideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for
17 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five
18 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any
19 postponed question that follows another electronic vote
20 without intervening business, provided that the minimum
21 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-
22 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-
23 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
24 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
25 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall

1 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
2 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
3 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.

4 SEC. 2. House Resolution 432 is laid on the table.
