# RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the bill (H.R. 4444) to authorize extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to the People's Republic of China.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 4444) to authorize extension of nondiscriminatory treat-  
4 ment (normal trade relations treatment) to the People's  
5 Republic of China. The bill shall be considered as read  
6 for amendment. In lieu of the amendment recommended

1 by the Committee on Ways and Means now printed in the  
2 bill, the amendment in the nature of a substitute printed  
3 in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying  
4 this resolution shall be considered as adopted. The pre-  
5 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,  
6 as amended, to final passage without intervening motion  
7 except: (1) three hours of debate on the bill, as amended,  
8 equally divided among and controlled by the chairman and  
9 ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and  
10 Means, Representative Stark of California or his designee,  
11 and Representative Rohrabacher of California or his des-  
12 ignee; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without  
13 instructions.
