Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4201) to amend the Communications Act of 1934 to clarify the service obligations of noncommercial educational broadcast stations.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 4201) to amend the Communications Act of 1934 to clar-
4 ify the service obligations of noncommercial educational
5 broadcast stations. The bill shall be considered as read
6 for amendment. The amendment recommended by the

1 Committee on Commerce now printed in the bill shall be
2 considered as adopted. The previous question shall be con-
3 sidered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any
4 further amendment thereto to final passage without inter-
5 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill,
6 as amended, equally divided and controlled by the chair-
7 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
8 Commerce; (2) a further amendment in the nature of a
9 substitute printed in the Congressional Record pursuant
10 to clause 8 of rule XVIII, if offered by representative Mar-
11 key of Massachusetts or his designee, which shall be con-
12 sidered as read and shall be separately debatable for one
13 hour equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
14 an opponent; and (3) one motion to recommit with or
15 without instructions.
