Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4516) making appropriations for the Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4516) making appropriations for
6 the Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending Sep-
7 tember 30, 2001, and for other purposes. The first reading

1 of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order against
2 consideration of the bill for failure to comply with section
3 401(a) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are
4 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
5 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
6 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
7 Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the
8 bill shall be considered for amendments under the five-
9 minute rule. The bill shall be considered as read. Points
10 of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply
11 with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. No amendment to
12 the bill shall be in order except those printed in the report
13 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.
14 Each amendment may be offered only in the order printed
15 in the report, may be offered by a Member designated in
16 the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable
17 for the time specified in the report equally divided and
18 controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not
19 be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a
20 demand for division of the question in the House or in
21 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
22 the amendments printed in the report are waived. The
23 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) post-
24 pone until a time during further consideration in the Com-
25 mittee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any

1 amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum
2 time for electronic voting on any postponed question that
3 follows another electronic vote without intervening busi-
4 ness, provided that the minimum time for electronic voting
5 on the first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes.
6 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
7 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
8 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
9 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
10 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
11 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
12 or without instructions.
