Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4811) making appropriations for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4811) making appropriations for

1 foreign operations, export financing, and related programs  
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for  
3 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-  
4 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of  
5 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to  
6 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and  
7 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member  
8 of the Committee on Appropriations. After general debate  
9 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
10 minute rule. When the reading for amendment reaches  
11 section 587, that section shall be considered as read.  
12 Points of order against provisions in the bill for failure  
13 to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except  
14 as follows: beginning with “: *Provided*” on page 11, line  
15 23, through page 12, line 8; page 80, lines 18 through  
16 24; page 121, line 1, through page 122, line 12. Where  
17 points of order are waived against part of a paragraph,  
18 points of order against a provision in another part of such  
19 paragraph may be made only against such provision and  
20 not against the entire paragraph. Before consideration of  
21 any other amendment to section 587, it shall be in order  
22 to consider, and to dispose of, an amendment to strike  
23 that section. During consideration of the bill for amend-  
24 ment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may  
25 accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the

1 Member offering an amendment has caused it to be print-  
2 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated  
3 for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments  
4 so printed shall be considered as read. The Chairman of  
5 the Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a  
6 time during further consideration in the Committee of the  
7 Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amendment;  
8 and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time for elec-  
9 tronic voting on any postponed question that follows an-  
10 other electronic vote without intervening business, pro-  
11 vided that the minimum time for electronic voting on the  
12 first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes. During  
13 consideration of the bill, points of order against amend-  
14 ments for failure to comply with clause 2(e) of rule XXI  
15 are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill  
16 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the  
17 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been  
18 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
19 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
20 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
21 with or without instructions.
