Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4942) making appropriations for the government of the District of Columbia and other activities chargeable in whole or in part against the revenues of said District for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4942) making appropriations for

1 the government of the District of Columbia and other ac-
2 tivities chargeable in whole or in part against the revenues
3 of said District for the fiscal year ending September 30,
4 2001, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill
5 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
6 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
7 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
8 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
9 ity member of the Committee on Appropriations. After
10 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
11 under the five-minute rule. Points of order against provi-
12 sions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule
13 XXI are waived except against section 153. No amend-
14 ment to the bill shall be in order except those printed in
15 the portion of the Congressional Record designated for
16 that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII, pro forma amend-
17 ments for the purpose of debate, and the amendments
18 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
19 panying this resolution. Each amendment printed in the
20 Record may be offered only by the Member who caused
21 it to be printed or his designee and shall be considered
22 as read. Each amendment printed in the report may be
23 offered only by a Member designated in the report and
24 only at the appropriate point in the reading of the bill,
25 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time

1 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by
2 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to
3 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-
4 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee
5 of the Whole. All points of order against the amendments
6 printed in the report are waived. The Chairman of the
7 Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time
8 during further consideration in the Committee of the
9 Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amendment;
10 and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time for elec-
11 tronic voting on any postponed question that follows an-
12 other electronic vote without intervening business, pro-
13 vided that the minimum time for electronic voting on the
14 first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes. At
15 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment
16 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House
17 with such amendments as may have been adopted. The
18 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
19 bill and amendments thereto to final passage without in-
20 tervening motion except one motion to recommit with or
21 without instructions.
