Mr. ROHRBACHER submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

RESOLUTION

To provide for the consideration of a private relief bill by the United States Court of Claims, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That the bill for the relief of Salah Idris
2 (“Idris”) of Saudi Arabia and El Shifa Pharmaceutical
3 Industries Company of the Sudan (“El Shifa”) now pend-
4 ing in the House of Representatives is hereby referred to
5 the United States Claims Court and the Chief Judge of
6 the United States Claims Court shall proceed with the
7 same in accordance with the provision of sections 1492
8 and 2509 of title 28, United States Code; the court shall
9 file its report within 18 months from the dates of filing
10 of the petition on behalf of Idris and El Shifa in the court

1 giving such findings of fact and conclusions of law therein
2 as shall be sufficient to inform Congress of the nature and
3 character of the demands as claims legal or equitable,
4 against the United States, and the amounts, if any, legally
5 or equitably due from the United States to the claimants.
