2 **SECTION 1. REFERRAL.**

3 The bill (H.R. 5481), entitled “A bill for the relief
4 of Sarabeth M. Davis, Robert S. Borders, Victor Maron,
5 Irving Berke, and Adele E. Conrad”, now pending in the
6 House of Representatives is referred to the chief judge of
7 the United States Court of Federal Claims.

1 **SEC. 2. PROCEEDINGS AND REPORT.**

2 Upon receipt of the bill under section 1, the chief
3 judge shall—

4 (1) proceed under sections 1492 and 2509 of
5 title 28, United States Code; and

6 (2) report back to the House of Representa-
7 tives, at the earliest practicable date, providing—

8 (A) such findings of fact and conclusions
9 of law that are sufficient to inform the Con-
10 gress of the nature, extent, and character of the
11 claim for the compensation referred to in the
12 bill as a legal or equitable claim against the
13 United States; and

14 (B) the amount, if any, legally or equitably
15 due from the United States to the claimants.
