AN ACT

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act for commencement of the construction of the Arrowrock Dam Hydroelectric Project in the State of Idaho.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
4 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.**

5 ~~Notwithstanding the time period specified in section~~
6 ~~13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would~~
7 ~~otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-~~

1 mission project numbered 4656, the Commission may, at
2 the request of the licensee for the project and after reason-
3 able notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
4 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and
5 the Commission's procedures under that section, extend
6 until March 26, 2005, the time period during which the
7 licensee is required to commence construction of the
8 project.

9 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
10 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.**

11 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—Notwithstanding the time period
12 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
13 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Reg-
14 ulatory Commission project numbered 4656, the Commis-
15 sion may, at the request of the licensee for the project and
16 after reasonable notice, in accordance with the good faith,
17 due diligence, and public interest requirements of that sec-
18 tion and the Commission's procedures under that section,
19 extend the time period during which the licensee is required
20 to commence the construction of the project for three con-
21 secutive two-year periods.

22 (b) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—Subsection (a) shall take effect
23 on the date of the expiration of the extension issued by the
24 Commission prior to the date of enactment of this Act under
25 section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806).

1 (c) *REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.*—If the
2 *period required for commencement of construction of the*
3 *project described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the*
4 *date of enactment of this Act, the Commission shall rein-*
5 *state the license effective as of the date of its expiration and*
6 *the first extension authorized under subsection (a) shall take*
7 *effect on the date of such expiration.*
