## AN ACT

For the relief of Marina Khalina and her son, Albert  
Miftakhov.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

2       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
3 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
4 1101 et seq.), Marina Khalina and her son, Albert  
5 Miftakhov, shall be held and considered to have been law-  
6 fully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-  
7 dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon  
8 payment of the required visa fees.

9 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

10       Upon the granting of permanent residence to Marina  
11 Khalina and her son, Albert Miftakhov, as provided in this  
12 Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer  
13 to reduce by the appropriate number during the current  
14 fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas available  
15 to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section  
16 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
17 1153(a)).
