Mr. DURBIN (for himself and Mr. FITZGERALD) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To convert 2 temporary Federal judgeships in the central and southern districts of Illinois to permanent judgeships, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISTRICT JUDGESHIPS FOR THE CENTRAL AND**
4 **SOUTHERN DISTRICTS OF ILLINOIS.**

5 (a) CONVERSION OF TEMPORARY JUDGESHIPS TO
6 PERMANENT JUDGESHIPS.—The existing district judge-
7 ships for the central district and the southern district of
8 Illinois authorized by section 203(c) (3) and (4) of the
9 Judicial Improvements Act of 1990 (Public Law 101–650,
10 28 U.S.C. 133 note) shall, as of the date of the enactment

1 of this Act, be authorized under section 133 of title 28,
2 United States Code, and the incumbents in such offices
3 shall hold the offices under section 133 of title 28, United
4 States Code (as amended by this section).

5 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—

6 The table contained in section 133(a) of title 28, United
7 States Code, is amended by striking the item relating to
8 Illinois and inserting the following:

“Illinois	
Northern	22
Central	4
Southern	4.”
