Mr. GRAHAM (for himself and Mr. MACK) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To revise the boundary of Fort Matanzas National Monument, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.**

4 In this Act:

5 (1) MAP.—The term “Map” means the map en-
6 titled “Fort Matanzas National Monument”, num-
7 bered 347/80,004 and dated February, 1991.

8 (2) MONUMENT.—The term “Monument”
9 means the Fort Matanzas National Monument in
10 Florida.

1 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
2 the Secretary of the Interior.

3 **SEC. 2. REVISION OF BOUNDARY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The boundary of the Monument
5 is revised to include an area totaling approximately 70
6 acres, as generally depicted on the Map.

7 (b) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The Map shall be on file
8 and available for public inspection in the office of the Di-
9 rector of the National Park Service.

10 **SEC. 3. ACQUISITION OF ADDITIONAL LAND.**

11 The Secretary may acquire any land, water, or inter-
12 ests in land that are located within the revised boundary
13 of the Monument by—

14 (1) donation;

15 (2) purchase with donated or appropriated
16 funds;

17 (3) transfer from any other Federal agency; or

18 (4) exchange.

19 **SEC. 4. ADMINISTRATION.**

20 Subject to applicable laws, all land and interests in
21 land held by the United States that are included in the
22 revised boundary under section 2 shall be administered by
23 the Secretary as part of the Monument.

1 **SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums

3 as are necessary to carry out this Act.
