6 REPORT.—Section 112(m)(5) of the Clean Air Act (42
7 U.S.C. 7412(m)(5)) is amended by striking “Within” and

1 inserting “Notwithstanding section 3003 of Public Law
2 104–66 (31 U.S.C. 1113 note; 109 Stat. 734), within”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
4 this section takes effect on the earlier of—

5 (1) the date of enactment of this Act; or

6 (2) December 19, 1999.
