1 **SECTION 1. CONTINUATION OF SUBMISSION OF CERTAIN**
2 **SPECIES CONSERVATION REPORTS.**

3 (a) ANNUAL COST ANALYSIS.—Section 18 of the En-
4 dangered Species Act of 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1544) is amend-
5 ed by striking “On” and inserting “Notwithstanding sec-
6 tion 3003 of Public Law 104–66 (31 U.S.C. 1113 note;
7 109 Stat. 734), on”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 this section takes effect on the earlier of—

10 (1) the date of enactment of this Act; or

11 (2) December 19, 1999.
