Mr. DASCHLE introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

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## A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to restore medicaid eligibility for certain supplementary security income beneficiaries.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicaid Eligibility  
5 Restoration Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RESTORATION OF MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY FOR CER-**  
7 **TAIN SSI BENEFICIARIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1902(a)(10)(A)(i)(II) of  
9 the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
10 1396a(a)(10)(A)(i)(II)) is amended—

1           (1) by inserting “, but for section 1611(c)(7),  
2           would be paid under that title, or with respect to  
3           whom such benefits” after “(or”

4           (2) by striking “(P.L. 104–193))” and insert-  
5           ing “(P.L. 104–193)”;

6           (3) by inserting a comma after “that section”;  
7           and

8           (4) by inserting “)” after “1905(q))”.

9           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
10          subsection (a) take effect as if included in the enactment  
11          of section 204 of the Personal Responsibility and Work  
12          Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–  
13          193; 110 Stat. 2187).

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
