## A BILL

To amend Public Law 104–307 to extend the expiration date of the authority to sell certain aircraft for use in wildfire suppression, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.**

4 Section 2 of the Wildfire Suppression Aircraft Trans-  
5 fer Act of 1996 (Public Law No. 104–307) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a)(1) by striking “September  
7 30, 2000” and inserting “September 30, 2005”;

8 (2) in subsection (d)(2)(C), by striking “and”  
9 at the end;

1           (3) in subsection (d)(2)(D), by striking the pe-  
2           riod at the end and inserting “; and”;

3           (4) in subsection (d)(2), by adding at the end  
4           the following:

5                   “(E) be in effect until September 30,  
6                   2005”; and

7           (5) in subsection (f), by striking “March 31,  
8           2000” and inserting “March 31, 2005”.
