A BILL

To extend filing deadlines for applications for adjustment of status of certain Cuban, Nicaraguan, and Haitian nationals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF FILING DEADLINES FOR APPLI-**
4 **CATIONS FOR ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS OF**
5 **CERTAIN CUBAN, NICARAGUAN, AND HAITIAN**
6 **NATIONALS.**

7 (a) NICARAGUAN ADJUSTMENT AND CENTRAL
8 AMERICAN RELIEF ACT.—Notwithstanding the expiration
9 of the application filing deadline in section 202(a)(1) of

1 the Nicaraguan Adjustment and Central American Relief
2 Act (as contained in Public Law 105–100; 8 U.S.C. 1255
3 note), a Cuban or Nicaraguan national who is otherwise
4 eligible for adjustment of status under that section may
5 apply for that status through the date that is one year
6 after the date of promulgation by the Attorney General
7 of final regulations for the implementation of that section.

8 (b) HAITIAN REFUGEE IMMIGRATION FAIRNESS
9 ACT.—Notwithstanding the expiration of the application
10 filing deadline in section 902(a) of the Haitian Refugee
11 Immigration Fairness Act of 1998 (as added by section
12 101(h) of division A of Public Law 105–277), a Haitian
13 national who is otherwise eligible for adjustment of status
14 under that section may apply for that status through the
15 date that is one year after the date of promulgation by
16 the Attorney General of final regulations for the imple-
17 mentation of that section.
